

Art Display Call for Entry – Selwyn Public Library Teen Art Exhibit



The Selwyn Public Library's Teen Advisory Group (TAG) invites teen artists (ages 13-18) to submit their work for inclusion in our Teen Art Exhibit. We are able to exhibit two-dimensional artworks including paintings, drawings, mixed media, prints, and photographs. Due to space availability, three-dimensional artwork will not be accepted. Each artist is invited to submit up to 3 works.

The Teen Art Exhibit will take place during the month of August at the Bridgenorth Library. An opening reception will take place Wednesday, August 6th from 5:45-6:45pm.

Two prizes will be awarded. The TAG Choice Award winner will be announced at the opening reception on August 6th. The People's Choice Award winner will be announced at the end of August. Voting for the People's Choice Award will take place throughout August in-person at the Bridgenorth Library.

Exhibits are unsupervised and are accessible to the public during the Bridgenorth Library open hours, except when the space is required for library purposes.

The Library reserves the right to reject or remove any works or art which are deemed unsuitable for library public viewing, or to change the manner of display. In particular, exhibits must be reviewed within the context of the public space and its users.

The Library will supply the necessary wall hanging equipment (hangers, hooks, stepladder).

Artwork must be labeled with the artist's name and contact information. Artwork must be ready to hang at the time of drop off.

Submissions are preferentially accepted from July 14 to July 30 at Bridgenorth Library, and will be hung by TAG members with the assistance of Selwyn Public Library staff. Submissions received after these dates will be considered based on the availability of space.

It is the responsibility of the individual artist to submit their artwork, the completed call for entry form and a signed Selwyn Public Library Art and Crafts release during the submission period to a Selwyn Public Library staff member at Bridgenorth Library.

It is the responsibility of the individual artist to pick up their artwork the week of August 25th. Artwork **MUST** be picked up by August 30 to ensure that the space is available for the incoming art display. We do not have room to store artwork after these dates.
