# Policy

Net proceeds from the Causeway Treasure Trove and the Ennismore Community Thrift Shop shall be accepted in support of enhanced library services in the Selwyn Public Library.

# Procedure

- 1. It is understood and agreed that the net proceeds from the Causeway Treasure Trove and the Ennismore Community Thrift Shop operation shall be shared equally with Chemung Community Care.
- 2. Net proceeds shall be accepted by the Bridgenorth & Ennismore Branch Librarians, or approved designate, on a monthly basis or as requested and put forward for deposit as part of the approved operational procedures.
- 3. An annual estimated revenue amount shall be determined, in consultation with the Causeway Treasure Trove and the Ennismore Community Thrift Shop store managers and included in the Board approved budget.
- 4. Expenditures required for the direct support of the store operations shall be discussed in advance with the CEO/Librarian and/or Treasurer and the Community Care representative.
- 5. Any approved expenditures shall be funded through the gross receipts from Causeway Treasure Trove and the Ennismore Community Thrift Shop.
- 6. The Bridgenorth and Ennismore Branch Librarians shall act as the day to day liaison with Community Care and the store manager, ensuring that operations at the store are operating effectively.
- 7. The CEO shall communicate on a regular basis with the Chemung Community Care representative to ensure the stores are operating effectively.
