

## What is PressReader?

PressReader is a service that connects you to digital newspapers, magazines, and other periodicals.

## PressReader Tips

- Use the Search Bar to find specific publications.
- Search collections or browse by country, language, publication type or category.
- Tap on the cover to choose a publication. Click on **Read** to download the publication and begin reading.
- To add a bookmark to a periodical, tap the three dots, then tap **Add Bookmark** and **Save**. You'll find your bookmarks saved under the **Bookmarks** tab on the app's main screen. Tap the page you've bookmarked and continue reading.

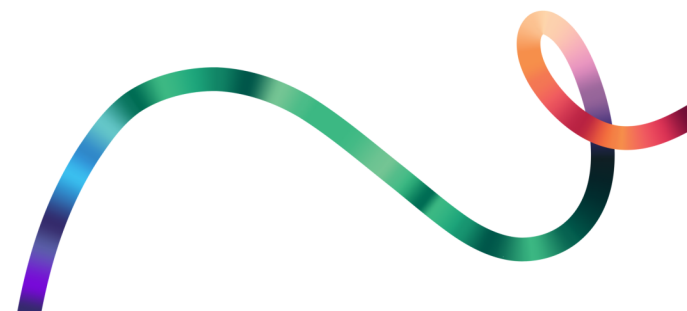

Download the PressReader app from the Google Play Store (Android) or Apple App Store (iOS).

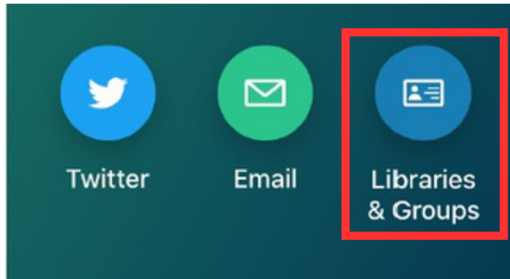


## Signing In

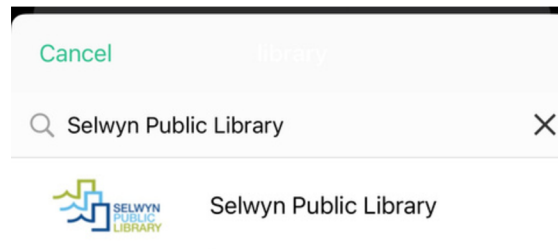
For **in-library** access, connect to your library branch's Wi-Fi, then go to [pressreader.com](https://pressreader.com) or open the PressReader app — you'll have instant access without logging in.

For **remote access** on [pressreader.com](https://pressreader.com), click or tap the Library or Group button on the sign-in screen.

For **remote access** on the **PressReader app**, tap the Libraries & Groups button on the sign-in screen.



Next, search for and select **Selwyn Public Library**.



Enter your **library card number** and **pin** and then tap Sign In.  
\*Please note: Your pin will be the same one you use for your Selwyn Public Library online account (the default is: books).
