The SPL Makerspace was opened in October 2022. This space is a collaborative workspace designed for making, learning, and exploring using high-tech and low-tech tools.

21 volunteers helped run the Makerspace in 2024. The SPL Makerspace held **68 programs** with **364 attendees**. The MakerShop, stocked with donated and volunteer-made products, made **\$6,327 in shop revenue** in 2024.
